Site Maintenance Member Tasks

Before the Festival

- Assist in moving any equipment around the site;
- Assist with any cleaning work on site;
- Assist in preparing the Soundshell amphitheatre stage and seating area; and
- Assist in preparing the Windsong pavilion stage and seating area;

During the Festival

- Assist as directed by the Site Manager;
- Assist with any cleaning work on site; and
- Because there is only ONE road onto the site, it is recommended that you be prepared to stay
 on site for the duration of the concert. If you need to leave during the morning, the road crew
 would have to stop the incoming traffic to allow you to leave so that is something they would
 rather avoid.

Wet Weather

Medical

If an emergency medical incident happens contact the medical team who are on site. Then inform the team leader/volunteer coordinator. Make sure you know where the site is please.

Duty Roster

Volunteers need to be at the site ½ hour before their shift starts each day. If your shift ends and another volunteer is to replace you, please do not leave your position until they arrive. Please organise your changeover during a break in performance or during applause.
